Assessable paving items on concrete pavement projects include:

- All PCC pavement – travel ways, ramps and shoulders, etc.
- Concrete flatwork on or adjacent to PCCP (curb and gutter, sidewalk, valley gutter, bikeways)
- Concrete pavement restoration (CPR) including full and partial-depth patching, slab stabilization, grinding, grooving, joint and crack saw and seal, and retrofitting dowels and tiebars
- Lean – concrete (econcrete) bases under PCC pavement

Annual Dues will be invoiced in December and will be due by January 30.
